REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure ridges moves allowing an ocean load of moisture into the area from broad low pressure centered in the Bellingshausen Sea. A lobe of low pressure develops to the northwest and will move east-southeast through Drake's Passage, grazing the tip of the Peninsula, easing wind speeds overnight. Another fast-moving high pressure ridge shoots through tomorrow, clearing skies, but bringing gusty southwest wind as it presses low pressure east...

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 3-5 light snow

Wind (kts): NW-NE 10-20, becoming Variable 5

Min Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F

Sky: Cloudy becoming Partly Cloudy; Cloudy by evening

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): SW 20-35, becoming NW 15-30 by evening

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -13°C / 9°F
