Sky: Mostly Cloudy becoming Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): SW 12-22, becoming NW 20-30

Max Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -14°C / 7°F

Visibility (SM): 1-3 fog, light snow, occasionally Unrestricted

Wind (kts): NW 20-30, easing to NW 10-20

Min Temp: -5°C / 23°F

Min Wind Chill: -15°C / 5°F

Sky: Cloudy becoming Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 3-5 light snow

Wind (kts): NW 10-20, easing overnight

Max Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F
