PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The recent weather pattern that featured fast westerlies over the Southern Ocean has abruptly changed to a stagnant weather pattern. A broad, weakening cyclone will remain nearly stationary just west of the Antarctic Peninsula the next few days. Temperatures will remain on the cool side but relatively light winds will prevent extreme wind chill values. Occasional disturbances will interact with lingering moisture to produce bouts of snow through the period.
