REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure takes control of Drake's Passage and the northern portion of the Peninsula with improved sky condition and good visibility. Wind speeds increase tonight through tomorrow as low pressure wheeling in from the west butts against the high, tightening the pressure gradient...
