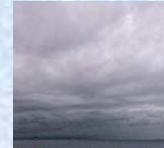

Sky: Partly Cloudy becoming Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): N-NE 15-25, becoming NE-E 30-50

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, chance of light snow early

Wind (kts): NE-N 30-50, becoming NW-N 12-22

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy becoming Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming ½ - 2 fog, light snow

Wind (kts): NW 10-15, becoming W 5-10 by evening

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F
