**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

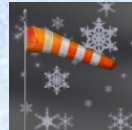
Out with one low pressure system, and in with the next! As the incoming low from the Bellingshausen Sea pushes closer, winds will remain quite gusty through the forecast period. Snow, blowing snow, and mist will hamper visibility significantly at times, but the snowfall will slowly diminish into tomorrow.

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasionally 1 – 3 due to snow, blowing snow, and mist

**Wind (kts):** NW 20 – 30, gusting to 45

**Max Temp:** -1°C / 30°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -14°C / 7°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasionally 2 – 4 due to light snow and mist

**Wind (kts):** NE 10 – 20, gusting to 25

**Min Temp:** -4°C / 25°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -12°C / 10°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasionally 2 – 4 due to blowing snow and mist

**Wind (kts):** NE 15 – 25, gusting to 45

**Max Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -13°C / 9°F
