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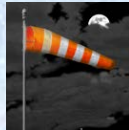
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system moving quickly through the Drake Passage will drag the persistent low in the Bellingshausen east through the day. Conditions will remain windy, but drier today. The winds gradually decrease and shift more south easterly tomorrow.
