Low pressure in the Southern Bellingshausen Sea continues to produce cloudy skies and predominantly west – northwesterly winds. Light snow this morning will gradually increase this evening with periods of heavy snow Monday.

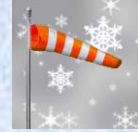

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, with Light Snow. Occasionally 4 – 6 in snow late afternoon

**Wind (kts):** Variable 8-13, becoming NW-N 13-18

**Max Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -9°C / 16°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 4-6 in Snow. Occasionally reduced 2-4 in Snow and Mist

**Wind (kts):** NW-N 13-20, with occasional gusts to 25

**Min Temp:** -2°C / 28°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -11°C / 12°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 2 – 4 in Snow and Blowing Snow. Occasionally reduced ½ - 1 in Heavy Snow and Blowing Snow

**Wind (kts):** NW-NE 18-28, gusting to 35

**Max Temp:** 2°C / 37°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -11°C / 12°F
