A series of low pressure systems will track into the southern Bellingshausen Sea producing strong NW though NE winds and steady moderate to heavy snow throughout the forecast and outlook period.

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, with Light Snow. Becoming 2-4 in snow. Occasionally reduced ½ - 1 in Heavy Snow and Blowing Snow

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 in Snow and Blowing Snow. Occasionally reduced ¼ - 1 in Heavy Snow and Blowing Snow

Wind (kts): NW-NE 20-30, gusting to 40

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5 in Snow. Occasionally reduced 1-3 in Heavy Snow and Blowing Snow

Wind (kts): N-NE 20-30 gusting to 40

Max Temp: 2°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F
