PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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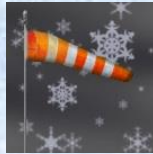
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system moves into the Bellingshausen Sea and intensifies today. Indications are for occasional peak gusts from the north-northeast up to 60 knots along with persistent precipitation. Expect a break overnight, followed by another surge tomorrow as a series of troughs rotate around the low in the southwest Bellingshausen Sea and along the west coast of the Antarctic Peninsula.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 2-4, with periods of 1/4-1 in snow, blowing snow, rain/snow mix, freezing fog/mist

Wind (kts): N-NE 10-20 gusts to 25, becoming N-NE 20-30 gusts to 40, occasional NNE 40-50 gusts to 60

Max Temp: 3°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy, occasional Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 4-6, with periods of 1/2-2 in snow, rain/snow mix, freezing fog/mist

Wind (kts): N-NE 10-20 gusts to 30

Min Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4, with periods of 1/4-1 rain/snow mix, freezing fog/mist

Wind (kts): N-NE 20-30 gusts to 40

Max Temp: 4°C / 39°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F
