PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system in the Bellingshausen Sea moves south along the coast of Alexander Island with another low pressure system developing west of Drake Passage. Indications are for strong northeast winds becoming west-northwest with steady precipitation beginning to decrease overnight. Expect periods of improving conditions until late afternoon tomorrow when next system moves into the region.

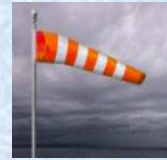

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5, with periods of 1/2-2 in rain, fog/mist

Wind (kts): N-NE 20-30 gusts to 40, becoming W-NW 15-25 gusts to 30

Max Temp: 3°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -8C / 18°F

Sky: Cloudy, occasional Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 4-6, with periods of 1-2 in rain, rain/snow mix, fog/mist

Wind (kts): NW-N 15-25 gusts to 30

Min Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -6C / 21°F

Sky: Cloudy, occasional Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, with periods of 1-2 in rain, fog/mist

Wind (kts): N-NE 15-25 gusts to 30, becoming NE 30-40 gusts to 45 late

Max Temp: 4°C / 39°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F
