PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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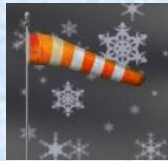
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A fast moving low pressure system strengthens and moves from the north into Drake Passage today, near Anvers Island tonight, then into the Weddell Sea tomorrow. Indications are for strong gusty north-northeast winds up to 60 knots late today and early tonight. Expect decreasing winds tomorrow, but an increase in precipitation as the low moves across the Antarctic Peninsula and into the Weddell Sea.

Sky: Cloudy, becoming Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, with periods of 2-3 in rain, rain/snow mix, fog/mist

Wind (kts): N-NE 15-25 gusts to 30, becoming NE 40-50 gusts to 60 late

Max Temp: 3°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy, occasional Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 4-6, with periods of 1-2 in rain, rain/snow mix, fog/mist

Wind (kts): NE-E 40-50 gusts to 60, becoming N-NE 15-25 gusts to 30

Min Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5, with periods of 1/2-2 in rain, rain/snow mix, fog/mist

Wind (kts): W-NW 20-30 gusts to 40

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F
