**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A weakening low pressure system in the Bellingshausen Sea northwest of Alexander Island allows for a high pressure ridge to develop and force next system through the Drake Passage tomorrow. Indications are for north-northwest winds decreasing and precipitation ending today. Expect favorable conditions and much colder temperatures tonight and tomorrow with southwest winds and snow late in the period.

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, with periods of 2-4 in snow, blowing snow, fog/mist

**Wind (kts):** NW-N 15-25

**Sky:** Mostly Cloudy, becoming Partly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted

**Wind (kts):** N-NE 10-15, becoming NE-E 5-10

**Sky:** Partly Cloudy, becoming Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, becoming 4-6 in snow late

**Wind (kts):** NE-E 5-10, becoming SW 12-18 late
