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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

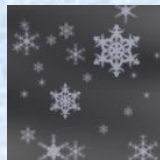
A low pressure system moving through Drake Passage today causes the low in the Bellingshausen Sea to weaken and allows for a weak high pressure ridge to develop between the two lows near Anvers Island. Indications are for favorable conditions with light northeasterly winds turning southwesterly tonight and ushering in low level clouds, below freezing temperatures, and precipitation through tomorrow.

Sky: Partly Cloudy, becoming Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, with periods of 1-3 in early AM fog/mist and snow vicinity late

Wind (kts): NE-E 5-10, becoming S-SW 5-10

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -9 / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 4-6, with periods of 1-2 in snow, fog/mist

Wind (kts): SW 8-12, occasional S-SW 15-20

Min Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -10C / 14°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, with periods of 3-5 in snow, fog/mist

Wind (kts): S-SW 8-12

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F
