PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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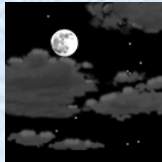
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A high pressure ridge is over the Bellingshausen Sea and west Antarctic Peninsula today with a low pressure trough exiting Drake Passage. Indications are for light winds and favorable conditions today and tonight with the potential for low clouds and fog forming tomorrow. Expect continued below freezing temps under high pressure tonight then a slight warming trend with a high just above freezing tomorrow.
