PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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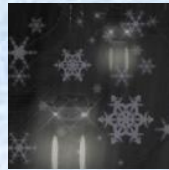
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A high pressure ridge is over the west coast of the Antarctic Peninsula from Anvers Island to the north moving to the northeast with a low pressure system moving into the Bellingshausen Sea. Indications are for light winds through the period with occasional low clouds and fog today. Expect increased cloud cover and precipitation tonight and through tomorrow as low pressure system moves into the area.

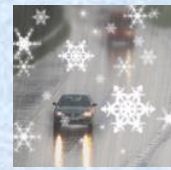

Sky: Partly Cloudy, occasional Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, with periods of 1-2 in fog/mist

Wind (kts): NE-E 8-12, becoming Variable 4-8

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -8 / 18°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy becoming Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5, with periods of 1/2-2 in rain/snow mix, fog/mist

Wind (kts): Variable 4-8, becoming W-NW 8-12

Min Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -5C / 23°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5, with periods of 1/2-2 in rain/snow mix, fog/mist
