PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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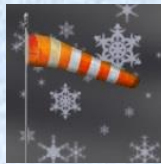
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A high pressure ridge moves to the northeast through Drake Passage and a low pressure system moves into the Bellingshausen Sea and intensifies through the forecast period. Indications are for increasing north-northeast winds, becoming strong and gusting near 50 knots by tomorrow afternoon. Expect light precipitation today becoming more persistent tonight with periods of heavy precipitation tomorrow.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, with periods of 2-4 in rain/snow mix, fog/mist

Wind (kts): Variable 4-8, becoming N-NE 10-20 gusts to 30

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -4 / 25°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5, with periods of 1-2 in rain/snow mix, fog/mist

Wind (kts): N-NE 15-25 gusts to 35

Min Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -5C / 23°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4, with periods of 1/2-2 in snow, blowing snow, rain/snow mix, fog/mist

Wind (kts): N-NE 25-35 gusts to 48

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F
