**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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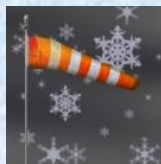
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A low pressure system in the Bellingshausen Sea intensifies and moves to the north near Anvers Island through the forecast period. Indications are for persistent precipitation and strong north-northeast winds gusting over 55 knots today. Overnight and tomorrow expect continued strong winds, decreasing late in the period, with below freezing temps and periods of heavy precipitation as the low center approaches.

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 2-4, with periods of 1/2-2 in snow, blowing snow, rain/snow mix, fog/mist

**Wind (kts):** N-NE 20-30 gusts to 35

**Min Temp:** 1°C / 34°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8C / 18°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 3-5, with periods of 1/2-2 in snow, blowing snow, freezing fog/mist

**Wind (kts):** N-NE 20-30 gusts to 35, becoming N 15-20 late

**Max Temp:** 1°C / 34°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -10°C / 14°F
