PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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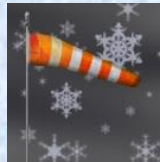
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Batten down the hatches as a low pressure system intensifies and moves into the Bellingshausen Sea from the west today. Indications are for high pressure exiting to the northeast early and strong north-northeast winds increasing through day with the potential for gusts up to 60-65 knots by late tonight and early tomorrow. Also expect persistent precipitation and periods of poor visibility through tomorrow.

Sky: Cloudy, becoming Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): N-NE 10-20, becoming N-NE 15-25 gusts to 35

Max Temp: -4°C / 25°F

Min Wind Chill: -12 / 10°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy, becoming Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 1/2-2 in snow, blowing snow, freezing fog/mist

Wind (kts): N-NE 30-40 gusts to 50, becoming NE 40-50 gusts to 62

Min Temp: -7°C / 19°F

Min Wind Chill: -17C / 1°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4, with periods of 1/2-2 in snow, blowing snow, freezing fog/mist

Wind (kts): NE 45-55 gusts to 65, becoming NW-N 15-25 gusts to 30

Max Temp: -4°C / 25°F

Min Wind Chill: -17°C / 1°F
