PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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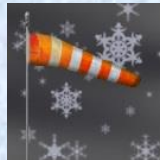
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Brace for strong winds today as an intense and broad low pressure system moves into the Bellingshausen Sea. Indications are for northeast winds with the potential for gusts up to 75 knots today, gradually weakening by this afternoon, but remaining strong throughout the forecast period. Also expect persistent precipitation, heavy at times, with periods of poor visibility through tonight and tomorrow.

Visibility (SM): 2-4, with periods of 1/2-2 in snow, blowing snow, freezing fog/mist

Wind (kts): NW-N 15-20 gusts to 25
