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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

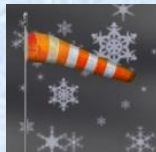
A low pressure system in the Bellingshausen Sea slowly moves towards the west coast of the Antarctic Peninsula through the forecast period. Indications are for continued strong gusty northwest winds shifting to northeast tonight as the low center approaches Anvers Island. Expect wind gusts up to 50 knots tonight with persistent precipitation and periods of low visibility through tomorrow.

Visibility (SM): 2-4, with periods of 1/4-1 in snow, blowing snow, rain/snow mix, freezing fog/mist

Wind (kts): W-NW 15-20 gusts to 25

Visibility (SM): 3-5, with periods of 1/2-2 in snow, blowing snow, freezing fog/mist

Wind (kts): NE-E 25-35 gusts to 50

Visibility (SM): 2-4, with periods of 1/4-1 in snow, blowing snow, freezing fog/mist

Wind (kts): N-NE 20-30 gusts to 40
