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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system moves to the northeast through the Drake Passage, followed by a second weak low circulation tracking north of Anvers Island, as a high pressure ridge strengthens over the Bellingshausen Sea. Indications are for favorable conditions with light winds today. Expect increasing low level clouds and periods of low visibility due to precipitation tonight followed by improving conditions under high pressure as precipitation ends early tomorrow morning.
