A low pressure system intensifies and moves eastward across the Weddell Sea as a high pressure ridge strengthens along the west coast of the Antarctic Peninsula. Indications are for strong southsouthwesterly winds today with periods light precipitation. Expect winds becoming strong westnorthwesterly tonight and tomorrow gusting up to 42 knots with more persistent precipitation, heavy at times, reducing visibility.
