PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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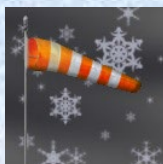
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Enjoy the minor break while it's here – because it won't last long! Today's "only" breezy conditions will give way to yet another round of gusty winds later tonight and into tomorrow, as another low pressure system crashes into the southern Antarctic Peninsula. Precipitation and fog will continue to hamper visibility throughout the period. The good news is that the northwesterly winds will once again bring warmer temperatures to the station.

occasionally 1/2 – 2 due to

to 35

Min Wind Chill: -19°C / -2°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1/2 – 2 due to
snow, blowing snow, and
freezing fog, occasionally 3 – 5

Wind (kts): NW-N 20 – 30,
gusting to 40

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -24°C / -11°F
