PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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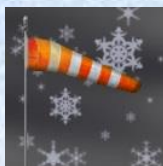
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A persistent plume of moist, mild air will remain anchored over the southern Antarctic Peninsula. This plume extends northward into the subtropical South Pacific. Brisk southerly winds, frequent snow, and steady surface temperatures near the melting point will continue.
