PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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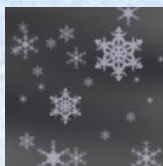
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The persistent plume of moist, mild air that has been affecting Palmer the past multiple days will finally move out of the region tonight. This weather pattern change will be accompanied by an end to the snow and brisk winds overnight, as well as cooling temperatures. Wind, snow, and temperatures will increase later tomorrow, ahead of a low pressure system moving east across the Bellingshausen Sea.
