REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Today begins under mild but cloudy conditions as low pressure to the north passes through the Drake Passage. High pressure building over the region will cause increased winds through the end of the day tomorrow. The southwesterly component of the winds will mean continued cold temperatures & stratus clouds, and snow is expected tomorrow.
