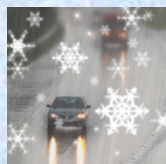
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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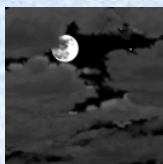
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Weak high pressure is currently in place, keeping things fairly tame for the moment. Cloudy skies will begin to break up slightly today, with winds slowly weakening into tonight. Tomorrow, however, a small low will begin to move in to the north of Anvers Island. This will bring yet another round of cloudy skies, snow, and stronger winds.

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted with light snow, occasionally 3 – 5

Wind (kts): W 15 – 20, becoming NE 5 – 10

Max Temp: -7°C / 19°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): NE 8 – 12

Min Temp: -8°C / 18°F

Min Wind Chill: -16°C / 3°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 1 – 3 due to light snow and mist

Wind (kts): NE 10 – 15

Max Temp: -4°C / 25°F

Min Wind Chill: -17°C / 1°F
