REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Enjoy the last of the pleasant high pressure today, because a large low begins to enter the Drake Passage later tonight. Cloud cover will fill in later tonight, and winds will quickly ramp up. Warming temperatures will create a wet a mix of snow and sleet, and although precipitation will be on the lighter side, the winds will reduce visibility in blowing snow at times.

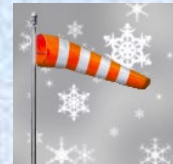

Sky: Partly Cloudy, becoming Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): NE 5 – 10

Max Temp: -4°C / 25°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy, becoming Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 4 – 6 due to light snow, sleet, and blowing snow

Wind (kts): NE 10 – 20, becoming NE 25 – 35, gusting to 45

Min Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2 – 4 due to light snow, sleet, and blowing snow, occasionally Unrestricted

Wind (kts): NE 30 – 40, gusting to 60

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F
