PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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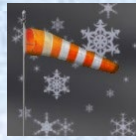
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A strong low pressure system continues to move from the Bellingshausen Sea eastward towards the extreme northern portion of the Antarctic Peninsula. This system will continue to bring precipitation, cloud cover and strong northeasterly winds gusting up to 40 knots and up to 60 knots until tomorrow afternoon when the winds will subside with snow and decreasing temperatures lingering throughout the rest of the period.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted becoming 3-5 due to light rain/snow mix and blowing snow

Wind (kts): NE 10 gusting 20 becoming NE 25- 35, gusting up to 45.

Max Temp: -4°C / 25°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 due to light rain/snow mixed and blowing snow, occasionally unrestricted

Wind (kts): NE 30 – 40, gusting to 60

Min Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5, occasional 1-2 due to snow

Wind (kts): E 10 gusting to 15

Max Temp: -4°C / 25°F

Min Wind Chill: -10/ 14°F
