### REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low weakens into a broad trough over Drake Passage, allowing higher pressure to build over the peninsula. Light variable winds are expected over the next 48 hours. Patchy sea fog is expected this morning as clearing skies encourage cooler temps under stable weather conditions. Expect clearing skies thereafter. Tomorrow, low clouds and sea fog move over the peninsula early morning.

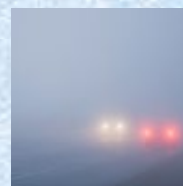
