PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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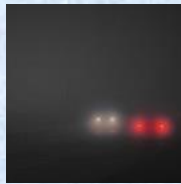
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system over the Weddell Sea extends a Narrow trough over the Antarctic Peninsula producing extensive cloud cover and intermittent light snow for the area. Light and variable winds are expected through this evening allowing foggy conditions to continue.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 due to fog occasionally <1-2 due to light snow and fog

Wind (kts): Variable 2-7

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F

Visibility (SM): 1-3 due to fog, occasionally <1 due to fog and light snow late evening through early morning

Wind (kts): S-SSE 5-10

Min Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy, becoming Partly cloudy by early evening

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): S-SW 5-10

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F
