**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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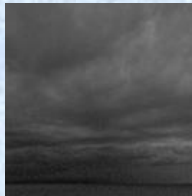
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Currently the Antarctic Peninsula is under the influence of a stalled low pressure system off the coast to the west. During the next two days, the low will begin to weaken and progress to the east. Clouds will begin to raise in the night, but moisture will remain in the upper levels. A similar set up will occur tomorrow with moisture moving back to the lower levels bringing mixed precipitation.

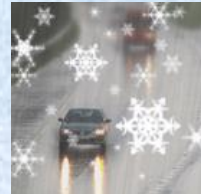
