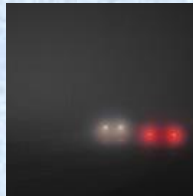
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure will begin to push in to the south west of station. Winds will weaken as the low moves into the Antarctic Peninsula and heavy precipitation will move to the east. Light snow and fog will be the main weather impacts for the next few days.
