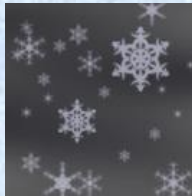
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Palmer Station remains under the influence of a low pressure system tracking across the Antarctic Peninsula. Moisture will continue to move in over Palmer causing cloud cover and precipitation throughout the next few days with periods of fog overnight.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 with mist and a rain and snow mix

Wind (kts): NW at 5-10

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Visibility (SM): 1-3 with mist and a rain and snow mix becoming ½ due to fog

Wind (kts): Variable at 5

Min Temp: -2°C / °F

Min Wind Chill: -5°C / 23°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): ½ due to fog becoming 1-3 with mist and a rain and snow mix

Wind (kts): Variable at 5

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -3°C / 27°F
