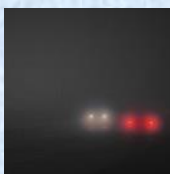
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A frontal boundary along the Antarctic Peninsula is producing extensive cloud cover over Anvers Island. Expect periods of mixed rain and snow to start your day, with improving conditions this afternoon. This evening will see fog roll in with the New Year.

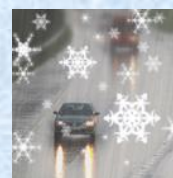

Sky: Mostly Cloudy, becoming Partly Cloudy by noon

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 2-4 due to light mixed morning rain and snow

Wind (kts): Variable 0-5

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -4°C / 25°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5, occasionally 1/2-1 due to fog

Wind (kts): Variable 0-5

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -5°C / 23°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5, due to fog occasionally 1/2-1 due to fog, mixed rain and snow

Wind (kts): Variable 0-5

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F
