REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A bit of a break may be in store from the low clouds and precipitation this afternoon into evening out ahead of the next frontal wave to move through. Expect a rise in temperatures, winds and cloud layers through midnight, then an abrupt drop in all three by tomorrow morning as fog, stratus, and cool temperatures once again settle in...

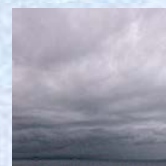

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 rain/snow mixed, fog, becoming Unrestricted

Wind (kts): NW 15-25

Max Temp: 4°C / 39°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F

Sky: Cloudy, occasionally Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 1-3 rain/snow mixed, fog

Wind (kts): NW 15-25 gusts 35, becoming NW 12-22

Min Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): ½ -2 rain/snow mixed, fog

Wind (kts): NW 7-15, becoming Variable 5

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -5°C / 23°F
