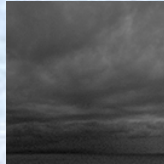
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Dante's third circle of hell describes well the forecast as the Palmer area will "wallow in a vile, putrid slush produced by a ceaseless, foul, icy rain" – and fog – under a weakening pressure pattern and approaching high pressure...Looking at a bit of redemption from the weather by tomorrow evening...

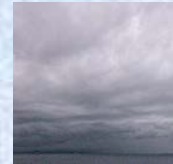

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 1/2-2 rain/snow mixed, snow, fog

Wind (kts): NW-N 10-15, becoming Variable 3

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -4°C / 25°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1/2-2 fog, rain/snow mixed, snow

Wind (kts): Variable 3

Min Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -3°C / 27°F

Sky: Cloudy, becoming Partly Cloudy by evening

Visibility (SM): 1-3 fog, becoming Unrestricted

Wind (kts): S-SW 6

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -3°C / 27°F
