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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Broad low pressure in the Bellingshausen Sea to sweep a vigorous frontal boundary across the area today, taking winds speeds into the 60-70 knot range by evening. Expect periods of reduced visibility in driving rain. Temperatures to skyrocket this afternoon with the minimum temperature being first thing in the morning. After frontal passage, wind speeds will remain elevated through the end of the forecast period...
