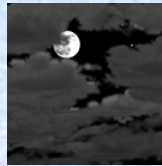
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low clouds cling to the peninsula with a good chance of restrictive fog today under weak pressure pattern. Low pressure development across Drake's Passage to bring an overall easterly flow to the area resulting in light winds, good visibility and variable cloudiness...
