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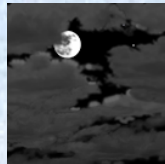
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A couple fast moving frontal waves to hit the peninsula the next two days starting this morning with high winds and periods rain. Winds should die quickly this afternoon with overnight clearing, then begin to ramp up by morning for another afternoon bout of wind and rain...

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 2-4 rain, becoming 1-3 fog, rain/snow mixed

Wind (kts): NE 35-50, becoming SW 6-12 after noon

Max Temp: 5°C / 41°F

Min Wind Chill: -4°C / 25°F

Sky: Cloudy becoming Partly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 fog, rain/snow mixed, becoming Unrestricted

Wind (kts): W 5-10, becoming N-NE 10-15

Min Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy becoming Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 2-4 rain by noon

Wind (kts): NE 20-25, becoming NE 25-40, easing to N-NE 15-25 by evening

Max Temp: 4°C / 39°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F
