

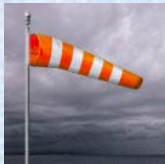

A bit of a break overnight through early morning with low clouds, fog, and light snow returning afternoon, early evening as high pressure builds in from the west...

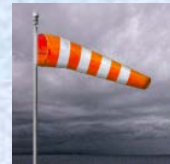

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 2-4 rain, becoming 1-3 snow, fog

Wind (kts): N-NE 25-35

Max Temp: 4°C / 39°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F

Sky: Cloudy becoming Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 fog, snow, becoming Unrestricted

Wind (kts): N-NE 25-35, becoming N-NE 12-20

Min Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy becoming Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 1/2-2 fog, snow by evening

Wind (kts): N-NE 12-22, becoming W-NW 10-15

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F
