A strong low pressure system just west of Anvers Island is slowly meandering its way northeastward into the Drake Passage. As it brushes by, winds will remain rather gusty through tomorrow, and intermittent rain will sweep through the area. Due to the low's slow movement, these conditions will last through tomorrow.
