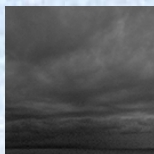
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Stratus field should bust out today as low pressure drops southeast through Drake's Passage bringing a freshening east-southeasterly flow to the area for the forecast period. Expect winds to become breezy by evening with good visibility and variable cloudiness...Happy New Year!!!
