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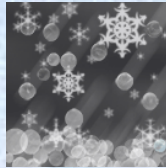
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure remains in place, keeping winds nice and calm. However, lots of moisture is being funneled towards Anvers Island, resulting in a heavy mix of fog and sleet. Tomorrow, a strong low pressure system approaches, and tomorrow night will see the winds pick up quite dramatically.
