**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Another low pressure system is approaching from the Bellingshausen Sea. Winds will remain blustery through the period, and with temperatures hovering around the melting point, a mix of wet snow and sleet will hamper visibility at times.

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasionally 3 – 5 due to snow, sleet, and mist

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasionally 1 – 3 due to snow, sleet, and mist
