PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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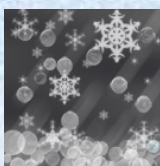
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A moist ridge is in place, sustaining light winds, mist, and sleet across the area. However, a large and vigorous low will push across the Bellingshausen Sea tomorrow, quickly ramping up winds and bringing heavy sleet along with it. Temperatures will rise with the northerly winds.
