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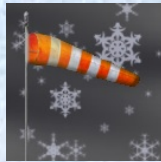
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Northwesterly flow persists as the low pressure in the Bellingshausen Sea slowly weakens...Possible breaks in the sky cover today before fog, stratus, and light snow blanket the area tonight through much of tomorrow...A fast moving frontal boundary to crash the peninsula overnight tomorrow with winds 50-60 knots...

Sky: Cloudy, occasionally Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 2-4 light snow, fog

Wind (kts): NW 12-20

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming ½-2 fog, light snow

Wind (kts): NW 15-25

Min Temp: 0°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): ½-2 fog, light snow, becoming Unrestricted

Wind (kts): NW 15-20, becoming NW 10-15, becoming N-NE 15-30 by evening; NE 50-60 by midnight

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F
