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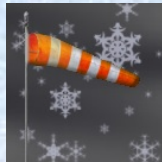
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Yet another low pressure system is approaching the Antarctic Peninsula. Winds will remain on the gusty side, with heavy sleet and fog dropping visibility pretty substantially through the period. With the northerly wind, temperatures will also remain warm, though wind chills will counteract that.
