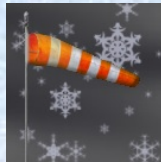
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A brief break from the violent weather is in store today, as a minor ridge passes overhead. Cloudy skies will continue to drop wet snow/sleet, but only a moderate breeze will prevail, weakening even more tonight. However, a new low pressure system begin to approach tomorrow, once again ramping up the winds and bringing another round of sleet.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 2 – 4 due to sleet and mist

Wind (kts): N 15-20, gusting to 25

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F

Sky: Cloudy, becoming Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 3 – 5 due to sleet and mist

Wind (kts): N 10-15, gusting to 20

Min Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy, becoming Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 3 – 5 due to sleet and mist

Wind (kts): NE 10-15, becoming NE 20-30, gusting to 40

Max Temp: 5°C / 41°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F
